No. - 6/लो० से० आ० - 103/2000 का० -117 In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 318 of the Constitution of India the Governor of Jharkhand is pleased to make the following Regulations determining the number of members for the Public Service Commission, Jharkhand and their conditions of service and making provision with respect to the staff of the Commission and their conditions of service.

PART I
PRELIMINARY

1. These Regulations may be called the Jharkhand Public Service Commission (Conditions of Service) Regulations, 2000.
2. In these Regulations, unless there is any thing repugnant in the subject or context –
 - (a) **“The Commission”** means the Public Service Commission for Jharkhand;
 - (b) **“Compensatory Allowance”** means an allowance granted in consideration of personal expenditure or loss of amenities of private practice, necessitated by the special circumstances in which duty is performed. It includes a travelling allowance but does not include a sumptuary allowance or the grant of a free passage by sea to or from any place outside India;
 - (c) **“Governor”** means the Governor of Jharkhand ;
 - (d) **“Member”** means a Member of the Commission and includes the Chairman;
 - (e) **“Service Member”** means a person who, before his appointment as Member, was in the service of the Government of India or of a State in India ;
 - (f) **“Parent Service”** means, in relation to a Service Member, the service under the Government in which he was employed before his appointment as such Member; and
 - (g) **“Service Pension”** means, the pension granted to a Service Member, under the rules of the Parent Service and signifies the gross amount of such pension prior to commutation, and includes the pension equivalent of service gratuity.

PART II
COMPOSITION OF THE COMMISSION
AND
PAY OF MEMBERS

- * 3. (i) The Commission shall consist of a Chairman and 4 (four) other members ;

Provided that in the case of absence of one or more Members on leave or otherwise, the remaining Members or Member, as the case may be, shall constitute the Commission.

- (ii) The Governor may appoint an additional Member when Member proceeds on leave preparatory to demitting office.

- ** 4. The Chairman may receive a pay of Rs. 70,380/- (Rupees Seventy thousand three hundred eighty only) a month and each of the other Members may receive a pay of Rs. 63,850/- (Rupees Sixty three thousand eight hundred fifty only) a month:

*** In case a retired officer is appointed as Chairman, his pay will be equal to his last pay drawn minus pension.

This amendment will be effective from 1.1.2006.

Provided that if at the time of appointment as Chairman or Member, the Chairman or the Member was in receipt of or had become entitled to receive retirement benefits by way of pension, gratuity, contributory Provident Fund or otherwise, the pay specified in the Regulation shall be reduced by the gross amount of pension (including any portion of the pension which may have been commuted) and the pension equivalent of other forms of retirement benefits, if any.

- 4 A. A Chairman or Member who, on the date of his appointment to the Commission, was in the service of the Central or State Government shall be deemed to have retired from such service with effect from the date of his appointments as Chairman or Member of the Commission.

PART III

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE OF MEMBERS

Section 1 (Leave)

5. A government servant appointed as a Member/Chairman of the Commission may be permitted to carry forward all the leave earned by him in the Government service to be availed of by him during the period of his office in the Commission. Subject to this, the calculation of leave admissible to such Members will be done in accordance with Regulation 6.
6. (1) A Member, who at the date of his appointment, was not in the service of the Government of India or of a State in India, may be granted leave as follows :-
- (a) Leave on leave salary equivalent to average pay up to 1/11th of the period spent on duty as a Member, subject to a maximum of four months at any one time.
- (b) Leave on medical certificate on leave salary equivalent to half the pay admissible on earned leave, subject to a maximum of three months at any one time.
- (c) Extraordinary leave without allowance, subject to a maximum of three months at any one time
- * (d) In one calendar year total 12 days Casual Leave will be admissible to Chairman/Members.

Explanation – All or any two of these kinds of leave may be granted in a Combination at one time.

- (2) A Member may, in addition to any leave salary he may be entitled to under clause (1) draw the service pension under the proviso to Regulation 4.
- (3) Leave accumulated in the name of a Member on the date he retires will be adjusted as follows :-
 - (a) Leave salary for the period of leave accumulated on date of retirement or for 180 days, whichever is less, will be admissible to the Member who was not on the date of his appointment in the service of the Government of India or in the service of any State of India.
 - (b) Leave salary for the period of leave accumulated on the date of his retirement including the period of maximum admissible leave adjusted during his service for a maximum period of 300 days will be admissible to the Member who on the date of his appointment or before it was in the service of the Government of India or in the service of any State of India.

7. The power to grant or refuse leave to a Member or to revoke or curtail leave granted to a Member shall in all cases be exercised by the Governor.
8. If the office of the Chairman of the Commission becomes vacant or if any such Chairman is by reason of absence or for any other reason, unable to perform the duties of his office those duties shall until some person appointed to the vacant office has entered on the duties thereof, or until the Chairman has resumed his duties, as the case may be, be performed by such one of the other members of the Commission as the Governor of the State may appoint for the purpose.

Section 2 (Pension)

9. In this section, unless the context otherwise requires :-
 1. **“actual service”** includes –
 - (i) time spent on duty as a member of the Jharkhand Public Service Commission;
 - (ii) time spent on duty by a member referred to in sub-clause (i) in the performance of such other functions as he may, at the request of the Governor, undertake to discharge, and
 - (iii) joining time on transfer to the office of Member from a post or an office under the Union or a State.
 2. **“service for pension”** includes -
 - (i) actual service,

- (ii) one month or the amount actually taken, whichever is less of each period of leave on full allowances;
- (iii) joining time on return from leave outside India; and
- (iv) any period not exceeding three months which, under the orders of the Governor, may, for special reasons, be added to the service for pensions of a Member;

3. **“pay including**, where the pay drawn by a Member during his tenure of office was varied on account of any change in the rate of pay deputation, leave, promotion from the office of Member of the office of Chairman or any other reason, the average monthly salary for the full term for which the Member has held office.

Explanation - The expression “full term” in this clause means any period not exceeding six years preceding the date on which the Member has vacated office.

10. Subject to the provisions of these regulations a pension shall be payable to a Member on ceasing to hold office, only if he has completed not less than three years service for pension. No pension shall be payable to a Member on his removal from office but in case a Member, who has completed three years service or more for pension, resigns from his office, and such resignation is accepted by the Governor, the pension admissible under these regulations shall be payable.

11. Pension under these regulations shall be payable to a Member, for life, subject to the condition that the pension shall be held in abeyance for any period during which he may subsequently be appointed to hold the office of a Member of the Union Public Service Commission or of a Member of Public Service Commission of another State :

Provided that the provisions of this regulation shall not apply to a Member who is, or becomes, qualified to receive a service pension, irrespective of whether he actually draws the service pension or the higher pension admissible under the proviso to Regulation 13.

- * 12. (1) In the case of Member who on the date of appointment was not in the service of the Union or a State, the pension to which such Member will be entitled shall –

- (i) in the case of a Chairman, if he has completed six years service for pension and has drawn pay at the rate of Rs. 70380/- (Rupees Seventy thousand three hundred eighty only) a month, be Rs. 1,38,000/- (Rupees One lac thirty eight thousand only) per annum and

- (ii) in the case a Member, other than the Chairman, if he has completed six years service for pension and has drawn pay at the rate of Rs. 63,850/- (Rupees Sixty three thousand eight hundred fifty only) a month, be Rs. 1,24,400 (Rupees One lac twenty four thousand four hundred only) per annum.

Amendment of aforesaid (i) and (ii) will be effective from 1.1.2006.

- (2) If a member has completed 'three years', 'four years' or 'five years' service for pension, be three-sixth, four-sixth or five-sixth respectively, of the full pension which would be payable to him, as the case may be, in accordance with clause (1)
- (3) Where the pay determined under clause (3) of regulation 9 in respect of a period of six years of service for pension of a member is less than the pay specified in relation to such period in sub-clause (i) or (ii) of clause (1), the amount of pension admissible per annum shall be the amount arrived at by multiplying the average monthly pay determined under clause (3) of regulation 9 with the amount of pension to which the Member would be entitled if his full, and not average monthly pay had been taken into account, and the product then being divided by the full pay mentioned in sub clause (i) or (ii) of clause (1), as the case may be.

(4) In case specified in clause (2) if the average monthly pay determined under clause (3) of regulation 9 is less than the full pay to be taken into account for purposes of the clause, the pension admissible shall be the relative proportion in each case specified in the said clause, of the amount of pension arrived at in accordance with clause (3).

13. (1) A Member who at the time of his appointment as such, was in the service of the Central or State Government shall, at his option to be exercised within a period of six months from the date of his appointment be entitled to draw his pension and other retirement benefits under the rules applicable to the service to which he belonged with effect from the date of his appointment as Member:

Provided that, in such an event, his pay as Member shall be reduced by an amount equivalent to the gross pension (including any portion of the pension which may have been commuted) and the pension equivalent to other retirement benefits and he shall be entitled to draw pension and other retirement benefits separately.

(2) A Member, who at the time of his appointment as such, was in the service of the Central or a State Government and does not exercise the option mentioned in sub-regulation (1), shall count his service as Member for pension and retirement benefits under the rules applicable to the service to which he belonged immediately before such appointment.

14. The pension payable under regulation 12 shall not be commuted but the pension under regulation 13 may be commuted.
15. The authority competent to grant a pension to Member shall be the State Government.

Section 3 (Travelling Allowance)

16. The travelling allowance of a Member will be regulated by the rules in force applicable to Government servants of the first grade :

Provided that –

- (i) The Chairman and Member shall be entitled to draw such travelling allowance respectively which is admissible to the members of Indian Administrative Service posted as Additional Secretary and Joint Secretary in Government of India.
- (ii) If he was not at the date of his appointment in the service of the Government of India or of a State, a Member shall be entitled to draw, for the journey to join his post, travelling allowance as for a journey on transfer.

Section 4 (Other Conditions of Service)

17. (i) Subject to the general condition that the amount of all compensatory allowance should be so regulated that the allowance is not on the whole a source of profit to the recipient the Governor may, subject to any conditions which he sees fit to impose, grant to any member any compensatory allowance other than travelling allowance and may fix the amount thereof.
- (ii) The Chairman and Member will be entitled to city compensatory allowance as admissible to the Government employees of the State.
18. The medical facilities admissible to the All India Service Officers and their family under **A.I. Service (Medical Attendance) Rules, 1954** will be admissible to the Chairman and Member of the Commission and their family.
19. A Member shall be entitled to subscribe to the General Provident Fund in accordance with the rules regulating that fund.
20. (i) If a residence owned or leased by Government is allotted to a Member, his occupation of the residence shall be subject to the rules which apply to an officer of the IAS provided that if the residence is one specially meant for a Member, the Member shall be liable to pay the standard rent of the residence or rent at the rate equal to 10 percent of his monthly emoluments, whichever is less, irrespective of whether he occupies the residence or not.

- (ii) A house building advance and an advance for purchase of a motor car to a Member will be regulated by the appropriate rules in force applicable to the Government servants drawing comparable emoluments.

PART IV

Section I (Composition)

21. The Staff of the Commission shall include one Secretary, as many Deputy Secretaries, Under Secretaries as required and such other gazetted and non gazetted staff as the Governor may, from time to time, determine in consultation with the Commission.

Section II

(The Secretary, Deputy Secretary, Under Secretary)

22. (i) The appointment of the Secretary to the Jharkhand Public Service Commission shall be made by the Governor for amongst the members of Indian Administrative Service / State Administrative Service not below the rank of Joint Secretary in the State Government.
- (ii) The appointment of Deputy Secretary and Under Secretary shall be made by the Governor from amongst the members of State Administrative Service holding suitable ranks in the State Government.

23. The appointment of all other Gazetted Officers (excluding Section Officers or the Officers in the line of Section Officers) shall be made by the Commission with the approval of the Governor.
24. The Secretary, Deputy Secretary, Under Secretary shall hold office at the pleasure of the Governor for a period not exceeding five years or till he attains the age of superannuation whichever is earlier.
25. If at the date of his appointment the Secretary, Deputy Secretary, Under Secretary was in the service of the Government of India or of a State, he shall receive the pay and special pay which he would have drawn but for his appointment as Secretary, Deputy Secretary, Under Secretary as the case may be.
26. In respect of all other matters, the conditions of the service of the Secretary, Deputy Secretary, Under Secretary shall be such as applicable to members of the concerned services in the State Government drawing comparable emoluments.

Section III (Ministerial Officers and Inferior Servants)

27. (i) The Ministerial Officers and Inferior Servants shall, subject to the control of the Chairman, be appointed by the Secretary.
- (ii) The scale of pay, Rule for recruitment and promotion and other conditions of service of the Ministerial Officers and Inferior Servants of the Commission shall be similar to those prescribed for the corresponding post in the Jharkhand Secretariat.

(iii) The Jharkhand Subordinate Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules shall be the Secretary and authority, which may impose any penalties prescribed in Rule II of the Appellate Authority shall be the Chairman.

28. In respect of all matters not specifically provided for in those Rules the conditions of Service of the staff of the Commission will be regulated by the general law of the Rules framed by the State Government under Article 309 of the Constitution of India for persons appointed to public services in connection with the affairs of the State.

29. If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these regulations, the decision of the Governor thereon shall be final.
