- Candidates whose marks have been uploaded are directed to fill the information in form – A enclosed herewith and email the same with all necessary enclosures. <u>It is compulsory to email filled form – A for</u> <u>candidates whose marks have been uploaded.</u>
- iii. Candidates(whose marks have been uploaded) who are willing to claim for increase in marks and also the other candidates who are willing to claim for increase in marks equal to more than the Cut Off Mark are instructed to email as per Instructions below:
 - For increase of marks from 10th standard to Post Graduation degree relevant mark sheets along with copy of provision/rule wherein calculation of percentage is clearly mentioned must be attached if claim for increase of marks is related to consideration of percentage.
 - 2. For claim of increase in marks for NET/JET/PhD:
 - i. <u>For JRF PhD</u>: JRF award certificate along with document regarding availing this JRF award for PhD awarded.
 - ii. For PhD as per 2009 UGC Regulation with NET/JET without JRF: Proof of PhD awarded as per 2009 UGC Regulation such as Pre PhD Course work certificate, PhD course work certificate, Certificate issued by competent authority for proof of PhD awarded as per 2009 UGC Regulation, Certificate issued by competent authority for clause 5(iii)

- a to e of the advt. etc. as may be the case along with PhD registration certificate and NET/JET certificate.
- iii. For NET/JET without PhD : NET/JET certificate.
- iv. 3. For claim of increase in marks for Experience:

i. <u>For teaching experience</u>: Copy of Appointment Letter along with Experience certificate issued by Registrar/Principal/Head of Institution.

ii. For post PhD research experience:

- 1. <u>For post PhD fellowship</u>: Post doctoral fellowship award certificate along with documents related to continuity of fellowship for the claimed duration of experience.
- 2. <u>For Research Associate/Research Scientist etc</u>: Copy of Appointment Letter and Experience certificate issued by competent authority.

3. For claim of increase in marks for Publication :

- a. For published papers in journals and best paper/poster award:
 Can be claimed as per schedule VII of Appendix A of the advt.
- b. For books and chapters in edited books: Can be claimed by attaching copy of relevant pages of books and chapters being published by University/National Institutes/Standard publishers along with ISBN proof if it is assigned to the books.

Claim for increase of marks must be relevant to information mentioned in sl. nos. – 19, 22, 23 and 24 of the application provided for Advt. No. – 04/2018

iv. Regarding Caste Certificate:

Caste certificate enclosed with the application are not found to be in order in the following cases:

- 3. Claim for increase of marks <u>received after 18.02.2022 will not be accepted.</u> Claim for marks increase by other modes i.e. other than email will not be accepted.
- 4. Caste certificate must be submitted at the time of document verification. After document verification caste certificate will not be accepted.
